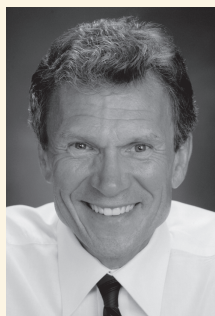

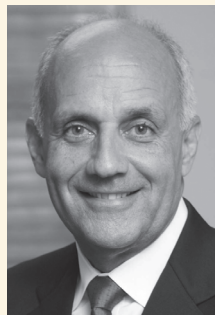

Although he is no longer in the Senate, Daschle continues to be a driving force in health care reform. In 2007, he joined with former Majority Leaders George Mitchell, Bob Dole, and Howard Baker to form the Bipartisan Policy Center, an organization dedicated to finding common ground on some of the pressing public policy issues of our time.
