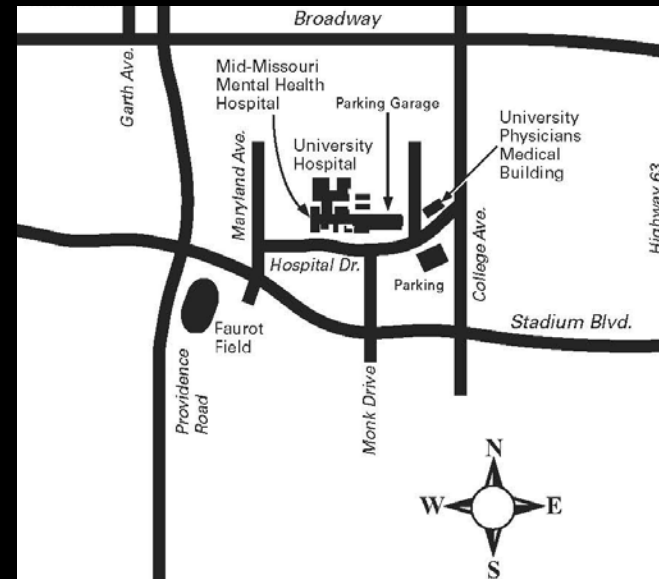

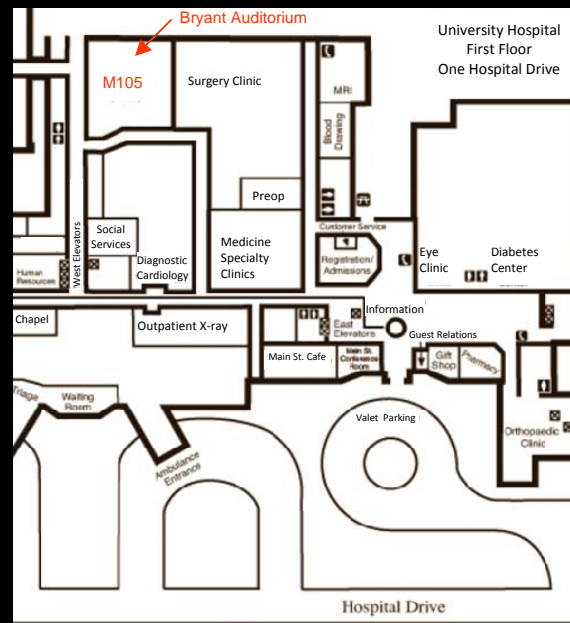


Directions and Parking

Introduction

This lectureship is sponsored by the University of Missouri School of Medicine's Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation program. The purpose of the course is to educate physicians and other health professionals who are familiar with the care of patients with traumatic brain injury on current issues in research and treatment.

Objectives

To improve understanding of:

- Mechanisms of arousal in patients with brain injury and pharmacotherapy options in this population.
- Clinical trials in traumatic brain injury and what has been learned and added to our understanding and treatment of brain injury.
- Potential targets for future research and current areas of investigation in brain injury research.
- Barriers to community reintegration and the approach to working with patients with brain injury on returning to home, work, driving, and school.
- Etiology and risk factors for mild traumatic brain injury (concussion) in sports.
- Current recommendations to mild traumatic brain injury in sports with care and return to play.
- Evaluation and etiologies of balance impairment in patients with brain injury.
- Current treatment approach for balance impairment in brain injury.
